



**RESOLUTION OF THE NEW JERSEY INSTITUTE OF TECHNOLOGY (“NJIT”) UNDERGRADUATE STUDENT SENATE APPROVING THE FOR THE IMPLEMENTATION OF AN ADVISOR EVALUATION SYSTEM**

**WHEREAS**, as it currently stands, NJIT students are allowed to evaluate their professors and classes but not their academic advisors or coordinators.

**WHEREAS**, Undergraduate students have approached the Undergraduate Student Senate with issues they have experienced with academic advisors and academic coordinator.

**WHEREAS**, Undergraduate students expressed interest in having NJIT create an “academic advisor evaluation” (“evaluation”) to possibly resolve some of the issues they are experiencing.

**WHEREAS**, the Undergraduate Student Senate agrees with these student complaints and supports the implementation of an evaluation system provided by NJIT.

**THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED THAT THE NEW JERSEY INSTITUTE OF TECHNOLOGY (“NJIT”) UNDERGRADUATE STUDENT SENATE HEREBY:** requests implementation of an academic advisor evaluation system for the purposes of discovering and correcting issues undergraduate students are experiencing with their academic advisors and coordinators.
